Pass the Whine Please

Can excessive whining cost us our souls? It may seem far-fetched to many of us, but a homily from Fr. Mike Schmitz looking at that question drew spirited discussion at our Average Joes meeting this past Saturday. I believe that most of us can honestly say we dislike whining, but to lose our souls over it seems a bit extreme. But a deep discussion concluded that it’s entirely possible.

Fr. Mike started with a personal story about a family reunion in which his mother thought it would fun to have everybody to wear a specific color T-shirt. Each color would designate one of her children, spouse and offspring. She also had a color for Fr. Mike and his sister, designating them as unmarried. This struck Father as “stupid” and he voiced his dissatisfaction over his T-shirt. But he didn’t just do it once. He brought it up to everybody he talked to at the reunion, getting more worked up with each conversation until finally he said to himself “What am I doing? I’m making others

upset because I’m making such a big deal out of a trivial matter.” And he let it go.

That generated a discussion among the Joes, acknowledging we all know whiners, and may even be guilty ourselves of over-blowing situations that are relatively minor. But aren’t there instances of legitimate complaints? Of course, there are - - and that’s why we need to differentiate between whining and complaining. Complaining involves voicing legitimate dissatisfaction, while whining is about something trivial. Complaining involves trying to right a wrong while whining is to annoyingly complain for little or no reason. But, at what point does whining harm our spiritual lives?

This is where it becomes a bit tricky. When someone’s whining is so constant that it starts to consume his or her persona, then that person is feeding the deadly sin of pride. In Fr. Mike’s opinion: when one’s whining becomes their truth, that’s when the danger of losing one’s soul comes into play. If we substitute our truth for “The Truth” of Jesus Christ, then we may place ourselves at risk of losing eternal life. Food for thought.

Speaking of food, (don’t you just love smooth segues?) last weekend my wife and I went to a barbecue at the home of a fellow deacon who was ordained with me. We were joined by two other classmates and their wives to celebrate our fifth ordination anniversary. There was some wining involved there, as well as “beering” (it’s a real word, seriously). This was all in moderation, of course. The food was excellent (no whining about the chef) and so was the conversation as we exchanged memories of our five years serving the Lord as deacons. We all agreed on this dichotomy -- our five years of service as deacons has seemingly gone by quickly despite the fact that the Covid year of 2020 was among the longest of our lives. We also agree that the consolations from God for diaconate service are as amazing as they are unique.

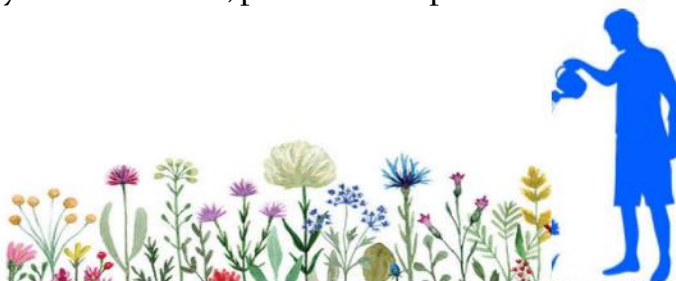

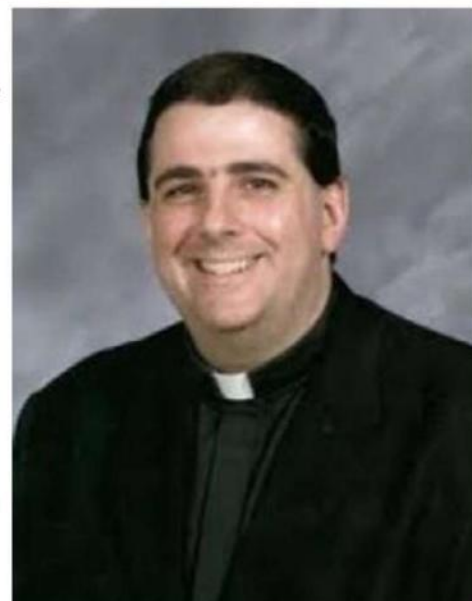


