

## In This Corner...

BOXING RING ANNOUNCER: "In the near corner, in the blue trunks and weighing in at 158 pounds, let's hear it for Mitch 'The Town Crier' Albom from DEEE-TROIT, MICHIGAN.

And in the far corner, in the red trunks and weighing in at 155-and-a-quarter pounds (154 without his beard), let's hear it for the man with many names, Simon, Peter, Cephas the Rock from CAPERRR-NAUM, GALILEE."
