

### One Step at a Time

When a child is learning to walk, the process normally is a matter of repetition --something of a "rinse and repeat" cycle. A step or two, followed by a wobble and a fall. This is generally followed by crawling to a chair or another stationary object, standing up and starting the process all over again until walking becomes second nature. The child learns that by taking one step at a time he/ she can build up to many steps, and walking no longer takes conscious effort.

The same type of process is evidenced in our faith. We don't wobble and fall physically as we struggle to go forward in our faith, but we most certainly wobble and fail spiritually. I'm talking of sin, of course. Our babies pick up visible bruises in the process of learning to walk. We bruise our souls even as we advance in our faith, though not visible to the naked eye. St. Paul reminds us: "We walk by faith and not by

sight" (2Cor 5:7).

If we have made conscious efforts to grow in our faith, to get closer to Jesus, it's easy to become afraid. Those closest to Jesus in his ministry often evoked fear. What he asks can seem overwhelming at times. We here at St. Joe's are not as likely as Catholics in Nigeria or China to become martyrs, but just standing up for our faith in a world driven by relativism can be a daunting thought.

God does not ask the impossible, though it may seem that way at times. For those of us living on the fringe of our faith, i.e. Sunday Mass only, what we need to realize is that we can ease our way closer to God. He's just looking at us to take the single step of faith. For me, for example, it was the first step of inquiring about diaconate formation, then another step to take my first class, then another and another until eventually I was kneeling before the bishop at ordination. I couldn't go from where I was in 2013 to where I am now in a single step of faith. And that's the point.

This parish can grow even stronger if we all just take the next step in front of us. For those of us living "bare minimum" Catholicism, that next step might be confession, which might then foster further steps. Or perhaps those wondering about the next step, maybe lay ministry is the next step (lector, Eucharistic Minister). If we are in lay ministry, then maybe the upcoming faith formation team represents the next step, a step that combines faith and creativity. For others, weekday Masses or attending a faith formation event as I listed last week are the way to go. The means by which we try to get closer to God are too numerous to mention, but it is important just to make that move to grow in

Exact numbers vary by internet searches, but suffice it to say that we see some version of "be not afraid" well over 100 times in the Bible. God is with us, so let's go ahead and take that next step toward Jesus.






